



# THE ONE ANOTHERS

Stir One Another  
*Hebrews 10:24*  
(Notes for leaders are in black)

## STIR: SECTION ONE

*TAKEAWAY: Define what it means to stir on someone, and identify ways in which this takes place.*

***And let us consider how to stir one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.***

**- Hebrews 10:24-25**

### 1. What do you think it means to be “stirred” towards something?

*Once responses are gathered, submit this as a good working definition of “stirred”: To be encouraged or inspired to the point of taking action.*

*Allow the group to augment or add to this definition until a comfortable consensus is reached.*

### 2. What is something that has stirred you towards good works in the past?

### 3. Why do you think meeting together is an important part of this “stirring”?

### 4. What could be at risk if we do not stir up one another towards love and good works?

## STIR: SECTION TWO

*TAKEAWAY: God created each of us with a purpose within His kingdom.*

***For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.***

**- Ephesians 2:10**

### 5. In light of this verse, what do you think “good works” are?

*Try to help the group see, through their responses, that good works are actions that build God’s kingdom (which makes us Kingdom Builders – one of the 5 Traits of Grace).*

## STIR: SECTION THREE

*TAKEAWAY: We are all gifted differently, but according to the purpose for which we were designed (according to Ephesians 2:10). It is, therefore, essential to help others see their gifts as we seek to stir them on to good works.*

***So we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another. Having gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, let us use them...***

**- Romans 12:5-6**

**6. What do you think is the relationship between the good works we all have to do and the gifts that God gives us in His body?**

**7. If part of being stirred towards good works is being able to identify and apply our gifts, how might we help others do that?**

## STIR: SECTION FOUR

*TAKEAWAY: Each person should have one action they can take to intentionally stir up others in their lives.*

**8. What can you do to actively to stir others towards love and good works and walk in obedience to this admonition in Hebrews 10?**

*This is the time to press each individual in the group into an actionable step. Once everyone has identified their step and is able to apply this lesson, take some time to pray for one another for courage and obedience as we seek to take those steps.*



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
